Practice with the Blue Stars Drum Line!

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The drum score is divided into three systems. The first system features a Snare drum part with a triplet pattern (R L R L) and a 40-measure rest, followed by a Q (Quadrant) part with a similar triplet pattern and a 40-measure rest, and a BassDrum part with a triplet pattern, a 6-measure rest, and a 6-measure triplet pattern. The second system continues the triplet patterns for Snare and Q, with a 'Shot' instruction for BassDrum. The third system features a 'Guts' triplet pattern for Snare and Q, and an 'Edge3' triplet pattern for BassDrum. Dynamics include *f*, *pp*, *p*, and *ff*. 'Sticks in' instructions are present for the final measures of each part.

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
